## Apprenticeship Incentive Grant for Women

Taxable cash grant of \$3,000 per year/level (or equivalent) up to a maximum amount of \$6,000 per person.

Requirements:

- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or protected person
- not be a high school student
- self-identify as a woman
- have the required AIG-W supporting documents
- be registered with your provincial/territorial apprenticeship authority as an apprentice in a designated Red Seal trade having low female representation
- have progressed in your training in designated Red Seal trades on or after April 1, 2018
- provide proof that you have successfully completed either the 1st and/or 2nd year/level (or equivalent) of apprenticeship

Application:

If you progressed between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2020, your deadline to submit an application is: 18 months following your date of progression.

If you progressed on or after January 1, 2021, your deadline to submit an application is: 12 months following your date of progression.

## Apprenticeship Completion Grant (ACG)

One-time taxable cash grant lifetime amount of \$2,000 per person for registered apprentices who complete their apprenticeship training and obtain their journeyperson certification.

Requirements:

- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or protected person;
- not be a high school student;
- have the required ACG supporting documents;
- show that you have completed an apprenticeship program as a registered apprentice in a designated Red Seal trade; and
- provide proof of your journeyperson certification in a designated Red Seal trade.

## Canada Apprentice Loan <https://www.pca-cal.ca/en/Home>

- Government of Canada offers apprentices registered in a Red Seal Trade apprenticeship program up to \$4,000 per period of technical training.
- You can get Canada Apprentice Loans for up to 5 periods of technical training.
- Your loan will be interest-free for up to 6 years as long as you are confirmed as being registered in a Red Seal Trade apprenticeship program.
- You do not have to make any loan payments as long as your loan is in interest-free status

### Requirements

To be eligible, you must meet **all** of these criteria:

- be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Protected Person;
- be registered in a Red Seal Trade apprenticeship program that is designated by the province or territory where you are registered as an apprentice;
- be enrolled in block release technical training or the equivalent full-time technical training with an approved technical training provider; and
- pass a credit check (required if you are applying for the first time)

You **are not** eligible if you:

- are a high school student;
- are an apprentice registered in the province of Quebec;
- are receiving a Canada Student Loan for the same technical training;
- have been told that you are restricted from receiving a Canada Apprentice Loan or a Canada Student Loan;
- have already received funding for 5 periods of technical training; or
- have already received 6 years of interest-free status.
